Children's Ministry - Our in-person programming for children is as follows: **The Nursery** (Room 118) is open but unsupervised for children aged 0-2. **Preschool-Aged Children (2-5 years)** are invited stay in the Sanctuary (Fireside Lounge) where an area is set-up for them. **Gradeschool Children** taking part in Sunday School will start in the sanctuary for a couple of songs before being invited to their class (Grade 1-3, Room 122 & Grade 4-6, Room 124). Please accompany them to meet their leaders if it is their first time. Gradeschool Children will be escorted back to the Sanctuary to join their parents/guardians near the end of the service. **** Note: Gradeschool children will participate in the services on April 2 & 9.**

Hearing Assistance - Devices are available at the Welcome Desk. Ask an usher for instructions.

Communion - We celebrate communion each week by coming forward to the table. If mobility is an issue for you, please use the yellow card you'll find near your seat to indicate that you'd like someone to bring communion to you.
