

A Christmas Discipleship Guide for the Whole Family

WHAT IS ADVENT?

Traditionally, the Advent season is a 4 week long period meant to prepare our hearts for Christmas-when we celebrate Jesus' birth! Advent means "coming." Similar to those who awaited the arrival of the Messiah over 2,000 years ago, in this Advent season we await the celebration of Jesus' birth and anticipate His coming again one day. This season we will examine Jesus Christ's coming through four domains of the Christian life.

THE HOME DOMAIN

WE BLESS OUR FAMILY BY ASCRIBING GOD'S PROMISE OF UNCONDITIONAL LOVE AND ACCEPTANCE TO THEM.

ABOUT THE 4 DOMAINS

The four domains of the Christian life are designed to help believers experience true fulfillment in Jesus Christ. We "START WITH THE HEART" - our personal relationship with Jesus. If we are experiencing true fulfillment in our heart domain we see the habit of RESTING in the truth of God's love. Next, the Home Domain reflects true fulfillment in Jesus through BLESSING those in our home. Then, if we are experiencing true fulfillment in Jesus in the Gather Domain, we prioritize GATHERING with a community of believers. Lastly, the Go Beyond Domain expresses true fulfillment in Jesus through the GOING OUT and sharing His love with others. The focus of the next four weeks will be to examine the themes of Advent through the domains of our lives.

There are endless ways to use this discipleship guide but the hope is that you would use it to continue to seek true fulfillment in Jesus Christ, starting in your own heart and home this Christmas season. The guide can be used individually or with your family to spark gospel-centered family discipleship.

HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE:

EACH WEEK WILL HAVE A FOCUS BIBLE PASSAGE, A FAMILY GO CHALLENGE AND FOUR BIBLE STUDY REFLECTIONS FOCUSED ON THE FOUR DOMAINS OF YOUR LIFE.

The chart above is the recommended path for each week but feel free to make it fit for you or your family. Breaking it up each day allows for time to process and seek God's guidance throughout the week. However, it may work better for you to sit down once-a-week and go over that particular week in one sitting. Find a rhythm that works for you or your family! If you are using the guide with your family, encourage younger children to answer questions by drawing pictures and then allow them to explain their pictures. The goal is not to just check the box by completing this but to spend intentional time with God this Christmas season. TIP: You may find it helpful to look ahead at all the Family Go Challenges to help prepare each week. We have suggested a few each week - you can do all of them or just one or two.

HIGHLIGHT WORDS THAT STAND OUT

UNDERLINE WORDS YOU DON'T KNOW

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. 2 He was with God in the beginning. 3 All things were created through him, and apart from him not one thing was created that has been created. 4 In him was life, and that life was the light of men. 5 That light shines in the darkness, and yet the darkness did not overcome it. 6 There was a man sent from God whose name was John. 7 He came as a witness to testify about the light, so that all might believe through him. 8 He was not the light, but he came to testify about the light. 9 The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world. 10 He was in the world, and the world was created through him, and yet the world did not recognize him. 11 He came to his own, and his own people did not receive him. 12 But to all who did receive him, he gave them the right to be children of God, to those who believe in his name, 13 who were born, not of natural descent, or of the will of the flesh, or of the will of man, but of God. 14 The Word became flesh and dwelt among us. We observed his glory, the glory as the one and only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

FAMILY GO CHALLENGE

Challenge Focus: Family/Friends/Neighbors

- Make and decorate cookies and bring them to your neighbors.
- Invite some neighbors over for dinner one evening and ask about their holiday traditions.
- Make a prayer garland/chain out of colorful red and green paper. Write the names of family, friends and neighbors on each chain link. Commit to praying for one person on your chain each day during December.

3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Because of his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead 4 and into an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you. 5 You are being guarded by God's power through faith for a salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time. 6 You rejoice in this, even though now for a short time, if necessary, you suffer grief in various trials 7 so that the proven character of your faith—more valuable than gold which, though perishable, is refined by fire—may result in praise, glory, and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ. 8 Though you have not seen him, you love him; though not seeing him now, you believe in him, and you rejoice with inexpressible and glorious joy, 9 because you are receiving the goal of your faith, the salvation of your souls.


HIGHLIGHT WORDS THAT STAND OUT

8 In the same region, shepherds were staying out in the fields and keeping watch at night over their flock. 9 Then an angel of the Lord stood before them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. 10 But the angel said to them, "Don't be afraid, for look, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people: 11 Today in the city of David a Savior was born for you, who is the Messiah, the Lord. 12 This will be the sign for you: You will find a baby wrapped tightly in cloth and lying in a manger."13 Suddenly there was a multitude of the heavenly host with the angel, praising God and saying: 14 Glory to God in the highest heaven, and peace on earth to people he favors! 15 When the angels had left them and returned to heaven, the shepherds said to one another, "Let's go straight to Bethlehem and see what has happened, which the Lord has made known to us." 16 They hurried off and found both Mary and Joseph, and the baby who was lying in the manger. 17 After seeing them, they reported the message they were told about this child, 18 and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them. 19 But Mary was treasuring up all these things in her heart and meditating on them. 20 The shepherds returned, glorifying and praising God for all the things they had seen and heard, which were just as they had been told.
